3. FILTERS

The number of filters distributed during this time period is unknown.

PEOPLE SERVED

Since January 1st up to June 30th we received 53 applications for tanks and 27 pre-sites were made out of the 53, and 14 sites out of 53 were installed.

11,050 people are now able to get water from the 26 tanks installed and other 4,302 people can now get water from the 10 repaired boreholes.

RECOMMENDATIONS AND CONCLUSION:

A- Policy is needed in regards to UWP's commitment toward tank installations that need repairs. A MOU will address this in the future, but for sites receiving follow-up calls and surveys policy is lacking.

B-Filter tracking- there is a gap in accounting for Sawyer PointONE filter distribution. Office staff will be designing a way to track this activity.

LOOKING FORWARD: The next quarter will have a greater focus on contacting UWP's original sites for follow-up surveys and questionnaires.
