PROJECTS COMPLETED

1. RAINWATER COLLECTION SYSTEMS

7 tanks have been installed since June to October in different districts of Uganda.

2. BOREHOLES

No boreholes funded during this period.

3. FILTERS

All of the 7 tanks above were given two filters (totaling 14) and an additional 18 filters were sold.

In addition to distribution, phone calls were made several sites to verify that filtration systems were functioning properly and to troubleshoot any difficulties recipients might be experiencing with the filters.

PEOPLE SERVED

3,650 people are now able to get water from the 7 tanks installed.

During this period we have received 2 applications from churches and 6 applications from schools.

FOLLOW-UP SURVEYS

The follow-up on the sites below was carried out using BASELINE or an IMPACT survey and we captured information of how tanks are operating now generally.
