

“Galaxy Funder”

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Description:

Galaxy Funder is a **WooCommerce Crowdfunding System Plugin**. It supports both backend Campaign creations for admin and Frontend Campaign submission for members. With Galaxy Funder, you can run a full fledged Crowdfunding site or add Campaigns for Crowdfunding on top of your existing WooCommerce Shop. All Payments are handled by WooCommerce. Galaxy Funder doesn't do anything related to the Payment handling of the WooCommerce Plugin.

Two types of Crowdfunding Campaigns are supported i.e. Fundraising by Crowdfunding and Product Purchase by Crowdfunding. **Fundraising by Crowdfunding** is the regular type of running a Crowdfunding Campaign for raising funds. **Product Purchase by Crowdfunding** can be used if a buyer wants to buy a Product from your WooCommerce shop by raising funds through Crowdfunding.

Email Notifications available for **Campaign Submission, Campaign Approval, Campaign Rejection, Campaign Deletion and Campaign Completion**. Shortcodes supported for Email Templates. Add **Perks/Rewards rules** for each Campaign. Also Perks/Rewards can be a Product from your WooCommerce Shop i.e. you can give the contributor a Product from your shop as a Perk/Reward. Campaigns can be closed based on **Target date, Target goal or Campaign never ends**. **Shortcode Generator** for creating Shortcodes for each Campaign.

Galaxy Funder is a **Very Comprehensive Crowdfunding Plugin** and you might have to read the documentation a few times and play with the Plugin for some time to get a good hold of the Plugin's working and functionalities.

How to Install:

There are two ways to install the Plugin. One is the Automatic Installation and another is the Manual Installation.

Automatic Installation:

- Unzip the “galaxyfunder.zip” you will find document folder and “gf.zip” . The document folder contains the documentation for your reference. And “gf.zip” is the actual plugin.
- Automatic Installation is the easiest option as WordPress handles the file transfers and you don’t even have to leave your web browser. To do an automatic install of Galaxy Funder, log in to your WordPress admin panel and go to: Plugins -> Add New.
- In the “**Upload**” field browse Plugin zip folder “gf.zip” and click upload. You can install it by simply clicking Install Now. After clicking that link you will be asked to **Activate Plugin or Return to Plugins Page**. Click Activate Plugin and the installation will automatically complete.

Manual Installation:

- Unzip the “galaxyfunder.zip” you will find document folder and “gf.zip” . The document folder contains the documentation for your reference. And “gf.zip” is the actual plugin.
- Using an FTP program or your hosting control panel, upload the unzipped Plugin folder to your WordPress installation’s wp-content/plugins directory.
- The Plugin works once you click “**Activate**”.
- Go to **Woocommerce -> Galaxy Funder**

Steps to Create a Crowdfunding Campaign:

A Crowdfunding Campaign can be created from **Backend by the Admin** and can also be created from the **Frontend by the Members**. First let us look into the Backend Campaign creation followed by the Frontend Campaign creation. Each Campaign creation is similar to WooCommerce Simple Product creation. In the Simple Product Page you have the option to Enable Galaxy Funder which when checked ON will turn the Simple Product into a Crowdfunding Campaign.

1. Create the Campaign from Backend by Admin

After Installing the Plugin go to Product -> Add New Product.

Create a **Simple Product** in WooCommerce and **enable check box for “Enable Galaxy Funder”** which will turn the Simple Product into a Crowdfunding Campaign. Enter the Minimum Price, Maximum Price and Recommended Price (which are all optional) for the Crowdfunding Campaign. Target Price and Target End Selection are essential fields. **Target Price** is the Campaign Goal amount. **Target End Selection** is used to select different ways of ending the Campaign like based on Target Date reached, Target Goal reached and Campaign Never Ends. Please note that you **must enter the regular price value as 0 or some other value, only then Galaxy Funder Plugin will display the Contribute button**.

Now Each Campaign has an option to create the **Perk/Reward**. You can enter the data like perk name, perk amount, description, max count for perk claims and estimated delivery. These customizations can be done in both backend as well as frontend.

Now Galaxy Funder supports two types of Crowdfunding Campaigns.

1) Fundraising by CrowdFunding

- It is the regular type of running a Crowdfunding Campaign for raising funds

2) Product Purchase by CrowdFunding

- If someone wants to buy a product in your site but he/she doesn't have money to buy then the user can create a Crowdfunding campaign to buy the product. The user can then promote the campaign with his/her friends for funding. Once the goal amount which is the product price is reached then the product is automatically added to the campaign creator's My Account page.

2. Create the Campaign from Frontend by Members

You need to show the Frontend Form for Campaign submission by Members. Create a new Page and insert the Shortcode **[crowd_fund_form]** to display the Campaign Form in Front End. In the WooCommerce -> Galaxy Funder -> Frontend Submission you can find all the options to customize this Frontend Submission Form.

Once the new Campaign is submitted by a Campaigner, it becomes available for Moderation in the backend. The Admin can accept or reject the Campaign. Publishing the Simple Product (Campaign) is equivalent to Approving the Campaign. Move to Trash before publishing is equivalent to Rejecting the Campaign. Move to Trash after publishing is equivalent to Deleting the Campaign. Campaigner will receive notification email (depending on Plugin Settings) when the product is approved, rejected, completed or deleted.

The Campaigns Created can be represented using Shortcodes and these Shortcodes can be placed in sidebar, pages etc.

When these Shortcodes are placed it displays the statistics of the campaign like Target Amount, Amount Raised, Minimum Amount, Maximum Amount etc,

When the user clicks on the statistics they are redirected to the campaign page where they can contribute their donations.

Minimum Contribution Label

Enter the Label of the **Minimum Contribution** Amount which is to be displayed on the Shortcode page.

Maximum Contribution Label

Enter the Label of the **Maximum Contribution** Amount which is to be displayed on the Shortcode page.

Goal Label

Enter the Label of the **Goal** Amount which is to be displayed on the Shortcode page.

Total Contribution Label

Enter the Label of the **Total Contribution** Amount which is to be displayed on the Shortcode page.

Total Contribution Percent Label

Enter the Label of the **Total Contribution Percent** Amount which is to be displayed on the Shortcode page.

Enable Title in Shortcode

If you wish to display the Title of the Campaign in the Shortcode then click on the check box.

Enable Description in Shortcode

If you wish to display the Description of the Campaign in the Shortcode then click on the check box.

Enter Number of words to Trim from Description

Enter the Count of the words which is to be trimmed from the actual description of the campaign.

Choose Inbuilt/Custom Design

Inbuilt Style

If this is selected then the default styles for displaying the Shortcode will be used.

Select Inbuilt Design

There are three styles available for displaying the Shortcode version of the campaign .You can choose any one of the styles for displaying the short code.

Select Progress Bar Style

There are two Progress Bar styles provided in the Plugin. By default Style 1 Progress Bar will be selected.

Inbuilt CSS (Non Editable)

The Inbuilt CSS are non editable .They can be used as a reference to create Custom CSS.

Custom Design

If Custom Design is selected Admin can use their own CSS to style the Shortcode version of the campaign.

Custom CSS

In this field User can enter their own CSS style the Shortcode version of the campaign.

Select Campaigns

The Campaigns created will be available once you click on the text box .You can choose any campaign to get their Shortcode.

Once a Campaign is selected their Shortcode is displayed below .This Shortcode can be placed anywhere .This displays the details about the campaign it also acts as a hyperlink to the Campaign.

You can also set up a PayPal Adaptive Split Payment gateway which is a part of Galaxy Funder Plugin.

By Using PayPal Adaptive Split Payment Gateway the Contribution Amount can be Split between the Admin and the Campaign Creator. The main (Admin) PayPal Account should be a PayPal Premier or Business account to use PayPal Adaptive Split Payment Gateway.

To Enable the PayPal Adaptive split Payment Gateway Check the **Enable/Disable** Check box.

Payment Mode

Payment Mode can be set to either Chained or Parallel. If Chained Is Chosen, The Payments will be transferred between the Admin and the Campaign Creator one after the other.

If Parallel is chosen, The Payments will be transferred between the Admin and the Campaign Creator at the Same Time.

Title

The Title of the Payment Gateway that will be displayed in the Checkout Page.

Description

The Description of the Payment Gateway that will be displayed in the Checkout Page.

PayPal Email

Enter the PayPal Email address of the Admin.

Percentage for Admin

Enter the Percentage Value between 0 to 100. This Percentage will be the share of Admin.

For Instance if the Admin Percentage has been set to 60 then, 60 percent of the Campaign's Contribution will be sent to the Admin and the Remaining Percentage will be sent to the Campaign Creator.

If the Admin Percentage Field is Empty then the Entire Amount will be sent to the admin.

PayPal Application Id

You need an Application ID In order for your PayPal Adaptive split Payment to Work. You can get the Application ID from PayPal. Check this link on how to get Application ID

You can get the Security UserId , Security Password, and PayPal Security Signature by checking the link .

Payment Cancellation URL

Enter the URL where the users have to be redirected if Payment has been cancelled.

PayPal Adaptive Sandbox

Enable PayPal Adaptive sandbox for testing Purposes.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. I am unable to activate the Galaxy Funder Plugin?

Please make sure WooCommerce Plugin is active before trying to activate the Galaxy Funder Plugin. Galaxy Funder is a WooCommerce Extension Plugin and needs WooCommerce Plugin to be active.

2. Can I run crowdfunding campaigns in my existing WooCommerce Shop site?

Yes. That is the idea of this Plugin. To run Crowdfunding Campaigns in your existing WooCommerce Shop along with your other products.

3. Can users create their own campaigns from front end?

Yes, users can create their own campaigns and submit it for site admin approval.

4. Can users edit their campaigns?

No, users can't edit but admin can.

5. How will the campaign look on my site?

The Plugin provides the functionality and the look and feel depends on your theme.

6. The Contributions made for the Campaigns are charged immediately or when the Target is reached?

It works more like indigogo where the contributions are charged immediately.

7. Who can create a Crowdfunding Campaign?

In addition to the admin any registered member can create and submit their Crowdfunding Campaign for admin approval.

8. Can I add Perks/Rewards to my Crowdfunding Campaign?

Yes, you can choose to add Perks/Rewards for your Crowdfunding Campaign.

9. Can I translate Galaxy Funder to my own language?

Yes. Please check the Language Translation in the documentation for more details.

10. Can I add a contribution manually for a campaign?

Yes. Please check the "How to add contribution manually" in the documentation for more details.

11. Contribution Button is not showing in Single Product Page?

If you leave the Regular Price as empty then this problem will occur. Make sure you enter 0 or some valid value in Regular Price and that should solve this problem.

12. How can I customize style of Single Product Page?

As of now we are supporting three inbuilt designs which is Minimal, IGG and KS Style

If you want to override the default designs, then in Single Product Page Tab select the Custom Design Option and Paste your Custom CSS.

13. Where I can create the Perk Option?

Go to Admin Dashboard --> Product--> Add Product then scroll down to bottom you can find the perk meta box to add perk rule.

14. Can I Select Multiple Perks? For Example let say perk 1 as 100\$ and perk 2 as 200\$ If I select both then 300\$ should be the total contribution.

Yes it is possible. You just enable the option of **Enable Multiple Perk Selection** in **Single Product Page**.

15. Layout are Changed in Single Product of Galaxy Funder once the Plugin is activated?

Actually the Layout is changed because of loading the template file from WooCommerce. Use the option in General Settings of Galaxy Funder scroll down to the Troubleshoot section. By Default it loads from Plugin. Change to From Theme and see if it helps.

16) Is there is a way to hide the Galaxy Funder Product from Shop Page of WooCommerce?

Yes it is possible. You can Show/Hide the Galaxy Funder Product from Shop Page of WooCommerce. This option is in Galaxy Funder -> General Settings.

17) Is there a way to Generate Shortcode of Particular Campaign?

Yes you can create a Shortcode for Particular Product in Shortcode Tab.

18) Campaign Product not added to Cart, once it redirects it says Cart is Empty?

Most likely it is causing by SSL. Check if you use HTTPS Plugin in which case go to Troubleshoot Settings of SSL and change the option as to Load Ajax from Site URL.

Caution and Troubleshooting

1. How to Activate Galaxy Funder

Galaxy Funder is a WooCommerce Plugin. Before Installing Galaxy Funder please make sure that Woocommerce Plugin is installed and it is activated. After Installing WooCommerce Install the Galaxy Funder Plugin and Activate it.

2. How to Create Crowdfunding Campaigns in Existing WooCommerce Shops

- Create a simple product and enable the Enable Galaxy Funder Checkbox.
- After enabling the check box select the type of crowdfunding campaign.
- If you want to set a minimum amount and maximum amount for contribution.
Then enter the minimum amount and maximum amounts. You can also hide those amounts from displaying it to the user.
- If the Contributor enters an amount lesser than the minimum or higher than the maximum amount then a message will be displayed to the contributor.
- Enter the Target Amount for the campaign.
- Select a method to end the Campaign from the list of options available.
- Users can create a perk rule for thanking their contributors.

Publish the product. This Product will behave like a campaign and contributors can donate to the Campaign.

Caution- If the Regular Price is not given the campaign will not be created.

3. How to Create Crowdfunding Campaigns from Front End

- Place the Shortcode [crowd_fund_form] in a page or a post or wherever you like to display the campaign Front End Submission Form.
- Users can create a campaign by filling the Front End Submission Form.
- Users have to select the type of the crowdfunding campaign.
- Enter the campaign title.
- Select the Campaign end method.
- Enter the Goal Amount
- The minimum amount and maximum amount are optional fields.
- Users can give a description about the Campaign.
- Users can create a perk rule for thanking their contributors
- Then click on Submit Button the campaign will be sent to the admin for verification and approval.
- When a campaign has been submitted . An Email will be sent to the campaign creator stating that their campaign has been submitted.
- Similarly when the admin approves or rejects the campaign, An Email will be sent to the campaign creator stating that their campaign has been approved.

- When a Campaign has been rejected or deleted An Email will be sent to the campaign creator stating that their campaign has been rejection or deletion.
- There is an option for limiting the number of campaigns that a user can create at a time
- If this is enabled and when a user exceeds the limit provided, An error message will be shown that they cannot create a new campaign.

Note: The user will be allowed to create a new campaign only when their existing campaigns are closed or completed.

4. How can User edit their Campaigns?

Once a Campaign has been created by a User using the Front end Submission Form they cannot edit their campaign .Only the admin can edit the Campaigns.

5. Appearance of the Crowdfunding Campaign in Different Themes

The Appearance of CrowdFunding Campaign depends on the Theme which you are using. There are three inbuilt styles available for displaying the Crowdfunding Campaign. You can choose any one of those or you can create your own style by selecting the custom styles option.

Paste your CSS for the classes displayed above in the Inbuilt CSS Column.

6. When the Contribution to the campaign are Charged

As soon a contributor contributes an amount to the campaign it will be sent immediately to the admin of the site.

Then the admin will redirect the amount collected to the campaign creator via PayPal split payment.

In PayPal split payment The Admin enters the percentage of share for them and the then enters the PayPal Credentials.

Through this method the amount collected through the campaign will be shared among the admin and the campaign creator.

There is an option for sending the amount collected directly to the campaign creator.

In the Payment Tab of the Galaxy Funder there is a checkbox for sending Payments directly to the campaign creator.

If this is enabled then the payments will be sent directly to the campaign creator.

7. Who Can Create a Campaign?

Apart From Admin Any Registered User Can Create a Crowdfunding Campaign .They have to fill and submit the Frontend Submission Form.

Once a Form has been Submitted it has to be approved and published by the admin.

8. Adding Perks/Rewards to the Campaign

- If you wish to add Perks/Rewards to your Contributors click on **Add Perk Rule**.
- Enter the Name of the Perk/Reward.
- If you wish to give any of the existing products in your store as Perks then select a product from the **Choose Products** option.
- Enter a Amount for the Perk
- Enter a Description for the Perk
- You can set a limit for claiming the perks or you can make them as unlimited claims selecting the type of claim from the **Limit Perk Claim** option.
- If you select the number of perks as limited then enter the maximum number of claims that can be made for the perk
- If you select the Limit Perk Claim as Unlimited then the perk claim max count field disappears. This means that you need not enter the count for the perk and the perk can be claimed unlimited times.

Note - If you select Unlimited Perks you can change the total number of perks claimed in galaxy funder settings in **Out of Claimed Label for Unlimited Perks** label.

9. Selecting Multiple Perks and calculate their total

Users can select Multiple Perks and their total will be calculated and will be added to the cart.

To Enable This Feature Goto

WooCommerce → Galaxy Funder → Single Product Page → Perk

Selection type

By default the value will be Single Selection you can change that to Multiple Selection.

10. Layout is changed once Galaxy Funder is activated

By Default the layout is loaded from the template file of WooCommerce . If you face any layout Changes after activating the Galaxy Funder plugin goto

WooCommerce → Galaxy Funder → General → Troubleshoot → Load

Template

By default the Layout is loaded from Plugin, Try Changing it to **From Theme** This might help.

11. Hide Galaxy Funder Campaigns in Shop Page of WooCommerce Shop

If you wish to hide the Campaigns in the Shop Page of your WooCommerce Shop then goto

WooCommerce → Galaxy Funder → General → Display Settings → Show Campaigns in Shop Page

By Default the option will be as show. You can change that to hide the Campaigns from the Shop Page

12. Generate Shortcode for Particular Campaign

If you wish to place information about a particular Campaign in any of your pages or post you will need a shortcode for displaying the campaign. Go to

WooCommerce → Galaxy Funder → Shortcode Generator → Select Campaigns

The Campaigns Created will be automatically shown in the drop down menu. You can select the campaign you want and the shortcode for that campaign will be displayed in the **Shortcode** menu.

You can place the shortcode anywhere you like. When you place this shortcode this will display the

1. Name of the Campaign
2. Target of the Campaign
3. Amount Collected

This acts as a hyperlink to the Croudfunding Campaign .When a Contributor clicks on the Hyperlink they will be redirected to the campaign page.

13. Campaign Products are not added to Cart when redirected it shows cart is empty

This issue is caused mainly by SSL. If you run a domain under HTTPS this problem occurs

To overcome this issue go to

WooCommerce → Galaxy Funder → General → Troubleshoot → Load Ajax From

By Default the option will be from Admin URL. If you face a problem in adding products to cart try changing it to Load from Site URL.

If you select a product for the perk then the title/name of the perk will be linked to the product page.

Shortcode Output in Page/Post

Language Translation:

1. Galaxy Funder is translation ready meaning you can edit the po files by which you can translate the text to any language.
2. The steps to do the translation are as follows. For eg let us consider translation to french.
3. Download and install [Poedit](#)

4. Open the file Galaxy Funder -> languages folder -> galaxyfunder-fr_FR.po using Poedit.
5. Choose the Source text and set its corresponding French text in Translation Text Area Save the changes
In wp-config.php define the WPLANG as French. Syntax is define ('WPLANG', 'fr_FR');
